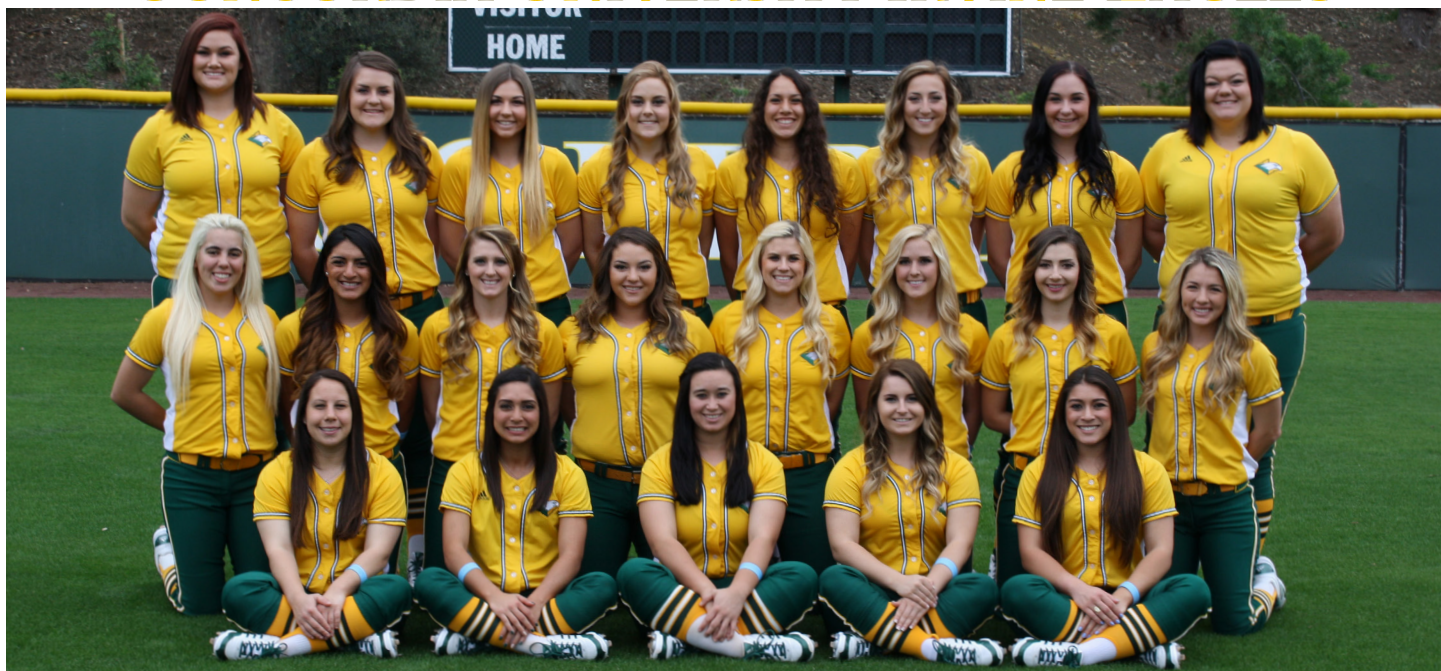

HEAD COACH CRYSTAL ROSENTHAL



Crystal Rosenthal brings in a record of 288-68 to her seventh campaign as head coach after winning an NAIA National Championship in 2013. She has won three-straight GSAC Regular-Season Championships, two GSAC/Cal-Pac Tournament Championships, a GSAC Tournament Championship, an NAIA National Championship and Opening Round Championship, been voted NAIA Coach of the Year,

and won three-straight GSAC Coach of the Year honors.

In 2013 she led the Eagles to the program's first NAIA National Championship with a 52-3 record. Rosenthal was voted NAIA and GSAC Coach of the Year, becoming the first Concordia softball coach to earn the national award, and garnering her second-straight GSAC COY honor. Her 2013 squad won their second-straight GSAC Championship with a perfect 16-0 conference record and second-straight GSAC/Cal-Pac Conference Tournament Championship. She is currently second all-time in wins and first in winning percentage at .809 on the Concordia career lists. Her 2013 pitching staff set school records in ERA (.63) and strikeouts (445).

Rosenthal's 2012 group won a program-record 56 games against 4 losses, including a mark of 15-1 in Golden State Athletic Conference play. Along the way they won a NAIA softball-record 44-straight games and broke school records in wins, runs scored (482), batting average (.382), hits (606), doubles (105), triples (21), home runs (84), RBI (430), and stolen bases (126). The Eagles pitching staff set a season record in strikeouts (430). Concordia finished the season ranked #6 in the NAIA Polls, and spent six weeks as #1 for the first time in program history. The Eagles won the second GSAC Championship in program history and first in 20 years.

Coach Rosenthal has won at least 40 games in all six of her seasons, including three-straight 50-win seasons. Nobody prior to her arrival had won 50 games in a season. She has coached seven NAIA All-Americans, three GSAC Player and two Pitcher of the Year winners, and 25 All-GSAC selections. Rosenthal coached four NAIA All-Americans in 2012 in Katie Carson, Katie Cotta, Amanda Fama and Jenna Jorgenson. Katie Carson was named the Capital One Academic All-American of the Year. In 2013 she coached three NAIA All-Americans including Katie Cotta, Shainna Groom, and Jasmin Dresser. Cotta was selected NAIA Pitcher of the Year.

She has led her team to the NAIA World Series in four of her first six years.

Rosenthal was promoted to her current post prior to the 2009 season after serving as an Eagles assistant coach for seven years.

Before coaching at Concordia, Rosenthal spent time as the varsity assistant coach at Calvary Chapel High School in Costa Mesa. She also served as head coach for the California Cruisers for 10 years, leading up to 2008.

A four-year player at Concordia, Rosenthal was a team captain for two seasons. She ranks among the top ten in 15 categories for single-season and career marks. Rosenthal posted 151 hits, including 21 doubles and five triples and knocked in 81 runs.

She was inducted into the Concordia Athletics Hall of Fame in 2008 for her career performance on the diamond.

Rosenthal prepped at Valley Christian High School in Bellflower, earning All-CIF and All-State honors as a junior and senior. She was named to the All-Olympic League team all four seasons.

Rosenthal earned her bachelor's in history and political science from Concordia, graduating in 2000, and earned her master's in coaching and athletic administration from Concordia in 2006.

In September of 2012, Rosenthal was named Senior Women's Administrator for Concordia Athletics.

COACH ROSE IMBRIANO COACH ASHLEY EVANS



Concordia assistant coach Rose Imbriano recently completed her 6th season with the Eagles. Imbriano has been Rosenthal's top assistant from the beginning and has helped mold a national power. As the team's primary pitching coach, Imbriano has guided the CU hurlers to a season record in strikeouts (445) and team ERA of 0.63. She also works with Concordia's defense and serves as the team's video coordinator.

In 2012, Imbriano guided a pair of All-GSAC pitchers in Katie Cotta and Courtney Young. Cotta was named GSAC pitcher of the year and an NFCA All-American. In 2013 she guided GSAC and NAIA Pitcher of the Year Katie Cotta.

Prior to joining the Concordia coaching staff, Imbriano began her coaching career as head coach for Calvary Chapel High School in Santa Ana, where she led her team to back-to-back CIF titles in 1998 and 1999. Imbriano was 70-14 as a coach and was named CIF Coach of the Year in 1998. Additionally Imbriano served as co-head coach for the California Cruisers Club team from 2001-2009.

A four-year letter winner at the University of Oregon (1992-95), Imbriano played, shortstop and first base, ending her career with 1,200 putouts and 111 assists against just 16 errors for a .988 career fielding percentage.

In her senior year, Imbriano started all 51 games and played 58 of 60 games in her junior year, where her team went 38-22 and advanced to the NCAA Regional at Fresno State.

After winning the Most Improved Oregon Duck Athlete in her freshman campaign Imbriano earned team Defensive MVP honors as a senior. Imbriano was the career record-holder in sacrifices until 2004, and laid down a team-high 19 sac bunts as a junior.

Imbriano prepped at Mater Dei High School in Santa Ana and earned All-Angelus League honors as a shortstop. Imbriano was named MDHS Scarlet Scroll Athlete of the Year in 1991. Imbriano graduated from the University of Oregon in 1995 with a B.A in journalism and later earned her MBA from Concordia University in 2007. Imbriano resides in Fountain Valley.



A three-time All-GSAC selection as a player, Ashley Evans returns for her eighth year on the Concordia softball coaching staff.

Evans played at Concordia from 2004-07, and was named to the All-Conference squad in three seasons, becoming just the second player in school history to do that.

As a 2004 freshman, Evans set the school record with seven triples, and is ranked in career records: at-bats (686), runs (145), hits (247), triples (18), and multi-hit games (75).

Evans earned GSAC and NAIA Scholar-Athlete accolades as a 2006 junior.

She graduated in 2007 with a bachelor of arts in history and a minor in political science.

COACH BRITTANY PEREDA COACH SHAINNA GROOM



Brittany Pereda joined the Concordia softball coaching staff prior to the 2013 season as an assistant coach.

Pereda played four seasons at NCAA Division I Loyola Marymount in Los Angeles, CA. She played first base, third base, and designated hitter in her career. She was a National Scholar-Athlete and on the PCSC

Commissioner's Honor Roll all 4 years. She graduated in 2012 with a business degree with a double emphasis on marketing and law.

She attended high school at Orange Lutheran and was the Trinity League Offensive and Defensive Player of the Year.

She is the oldest of four children with two sisters and one brother. Pereda has volunteered with the Giving Children Hope Foundation, Hurricane Katrina Relief Trip, and enjoys country music, reading, and dancing in her spare time.



Shainna Groom joined the Concordia coaching staff in 2014 after playing for the Eagles from 2010-13. With the Eagles she won a GSAC Championship in 2012 and 2013, a GSAC-Cal Pac Tournament Championship in 2012 and 2013, an NAIA National Championship in 2013, was named All-GSAC and Second Team NAIA-American in 2013, and

advanced to the NAIA Softball Championship three times.

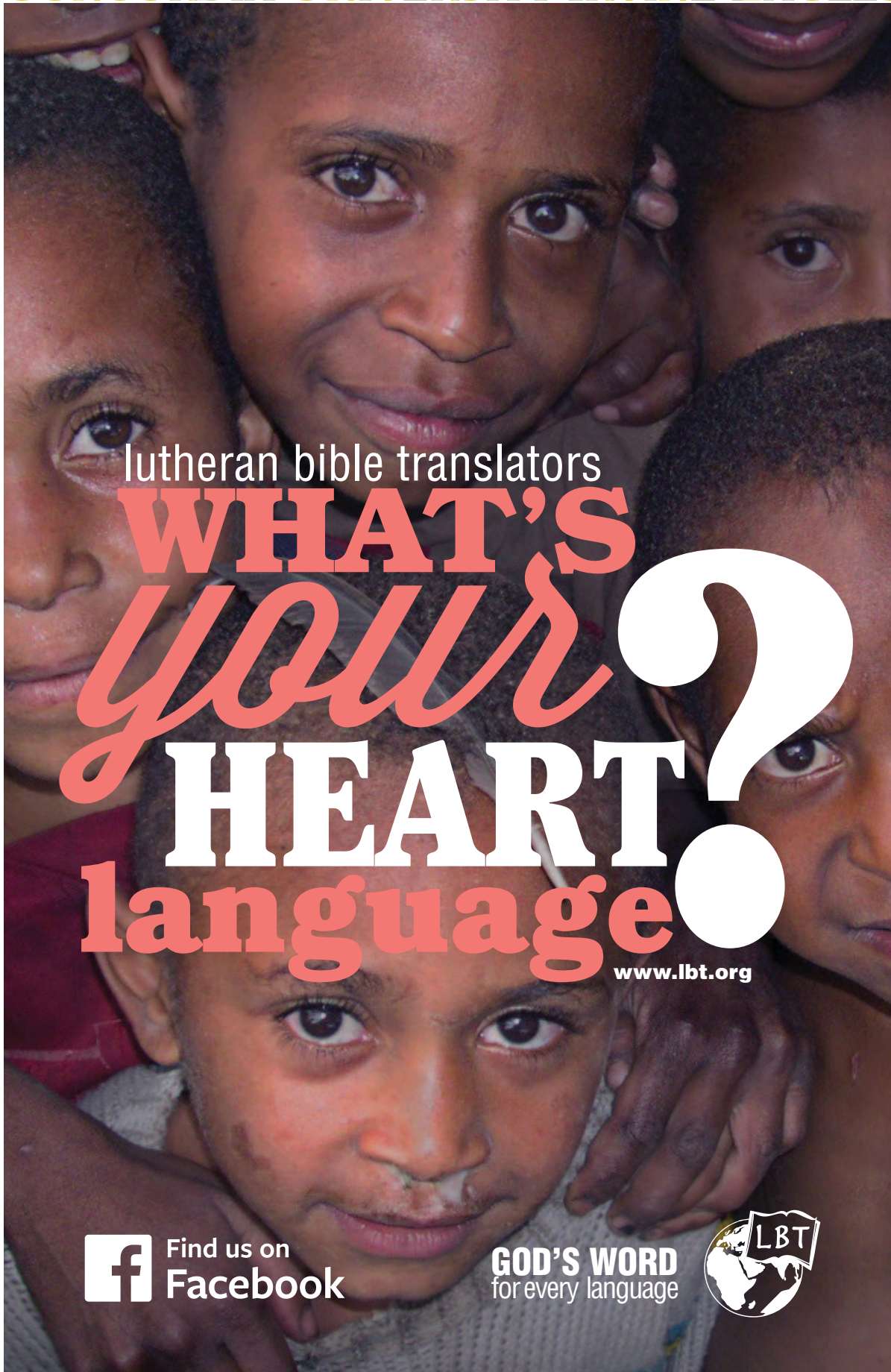
With the Eagles Groom was a career .360 hitter with 108 hits, 15 doubles, 14 homers, and 96 RBI. She drew 21 walks as a utility player in four seasons, playing a total of 117 games. She hit two doubles in a game on two occasions in 2013, both against Arizona Christian, and took seven total bases against Biola on April 13, 2013.

She graduated from Concordia in 2013 with a B.A. in liberal studies. She is currently enrolled in the Master's in Coaching and Athletic Administration at Concordia.

CONCORDIA UNIVERSITY IRVINE EAGLES ATHLETIC FACILITIES



Built in 1989 with a seating capacity of 2,400, CU Arena serves as home court for Concordia basketball and volleyball. It served as the home court for the 2003 & 2012 NAIA Men's Basketball National Championship Eagles, and the 2012 Women's Volleyball and 2013 Men's Volleyball NAIA National Champions. Concordia's training facilities, as well as the locker rooms, are located within CU Arena, and Concordia Athletics is headquartered at the mezzanine level in the southeast corner of the facility. The facility features a four-sided center hanging scoreboard and two



endzone scoreboards on each wall.

Visually, the arena is dominated by a center-court inlay of the Concordia Athletics logo, while the walls are decorated with championship banners from all sports. The Eagles Nest offers an enclosed viewing area through giant glass panes.

Concessions are open and available during home athletics events, and located on the southeast portion of the facility. All home games are video streamed free of charge. New baseline logo padding and a LED scoretable were installed in 2012.

Originally built in 1989 with the CU Arena, the current athletic training facility was added in 2002 and is located in the lower level of the gym in the southeast corner of the facility. The original athletic training facility was repurposed in 2007 as the lab instruction room for athletic training students.

Originally built in 1989 with the CU Arena, the locker room facilities were renovated and expanded in 2007.

Office spaces were added to the CU Arena in 2002 and expanded in 2007.



Built in 1995 and located on the southwest portion of the Concordia campus, Eagles Field provides several open viewing sections, most notably from the walkway located behind the outfield fencing and the sloped lawn behind the first-base dugout. Seatback folding seats were installed behind home plate in 2013.



The baseball facility includes an enclosed batting cage, bullpen areas for both teams that are sectioned off out of play down each line, and grandstand sections on either side behind the backstop. The Eagles baseball team has their own on-site clubhouse.

Wireless internet connection is available at the field, and fans can follow home games via livestats. A brick layered backstop and Concordia logo padding were installed in 2012. Concessions are available behind the third base dugout and offer Concordia baseball merchandise as well. The outfield flag pole showcases Concordia's 2011 NAIA National Championship banner. Wind screening was installed throughout the facility in 2014.

Built in 1990 and tucked in below the soccer and track facility, the softball field includes a fully enclosed weight room and batting cage, along with an enclosed bullpen area down the left-field line. The field is home to the 2013 NAIA Softball National Champion Eagles.

There is an open bullpen area down the right-field line available to visiting teams.

Fans are welcome to sit directly behind either the third or



first-base side of the backstop in the two rows of stadium seats, or down the right-field line near the fencing.

A new press row area was built prior to the 2010 season, and wireless internet access is available. All home games are video streamed free of charge. A new scoreboard and outfield Concordia logo windscreen were installed in 2012. Concordia banners were installed on the flag poles, dugouts, and batting cages prior to the 2012 season. A new outfield flag pole and backstop logo were also installed in 2012.



Renovated prior to the 2005 season, Eagles Field is home to Concordia men's and women's soccer as well as Concordia track and field.

Featuring state-of-the-art field turf, Eagles Field provides a picturesque view of the Concordia campus and offers nearby parking at the dormitories and adjacent to the baseball field.

The facility is equipped with a team room that is shared by both soccer teams, with running lanes, shot put surface, long and high jump landing area, and two sections of bleachers on the near side of the field. A fence was installed enclosing the facility in 2012.

No sunflower seeds are allowed on Eagles Field.

Wireless internet access is available and fans can follow livestats for home soccer games. Eagles Field hosted a women's soccer NAIA Opening Round game in 2011 & a men's game in 2012. A new state-of-the-art LED scoreboard was installed in 2012. Two storage facilities encased with Eagle logo windscreening were installed on both ends of the field, and in the spring of 2014 a video equipment shed for internet broadcasting was added on the north side of the track.



CONCORDIA UNIVERSITY IRVINE EAGLES ATHLETIC FACILITIES



Built in 1994 as the practice home of Concordia tennis, CU Tennis Courts are located between the dormitory area and the Student Union, on the east side of CU Arena. While some home matches are played on CU Tennis Courts, the majority of

in-season competition is played off-campus. Seating is available on the western end of the complex, with two sections of bleachers located on either side of the players' entrance.



Home to Concordia swimming and diving, as well as Concordia water polo, the William Woollett Jr. Aquatic Center is one of the premier aquatic complexes in the country.

With the use of two 50 meter pools and one multi-use pool, the center was built to attract some of the swimming world's most elite competitions.

Since its renovation in 2004, the Woollett Aquatic Center has played host to several major competitions including USA Swimming's National & Jr. National Championships in 2005 and 2006.

It was also the home to the Mutual of Omaha's Dual in the Pool which faced off two of the world's swimming power houses, the United States vs. Australia.

Constructed in 2014, the Concordia University Weight Room is located at the Soccer and Track & Field Complex. The facility has squat racks, benches, and free weights. It is a fully enclosed facility with power.

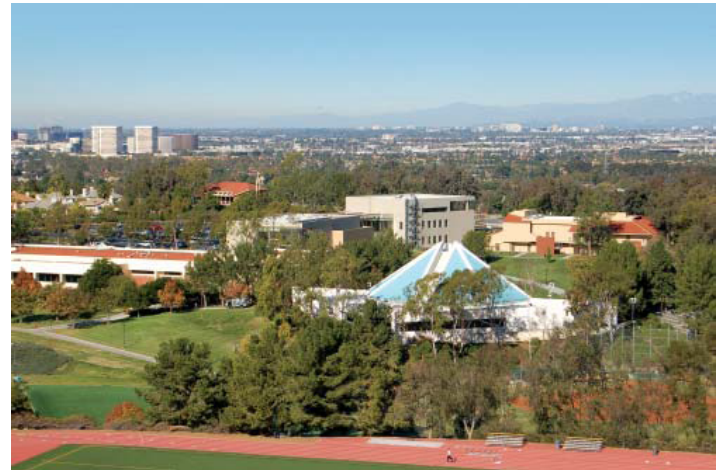
